Methodology

The accessibility assessment focused on the website's main flows, analyzing the most relevant pages, key features, and related services. Specifically, the assessment verified the compliance of sample pages and individual pages with the Level AA (double A) requirements of the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 del W3C.

The evaluation did not take into account the PDF documents downloadable from the website.

In conducting the test, the pages were examined using the following search engines:

- Google Chrome Desktop
- Google Chrome Android (XIAMI MiA3)
- Safari para MacOS
- •Safari para iOS (Iphone 11)
- Screen Reader VoiceOver in combination with Safari for MacOS.

Where the verification used semi-automatic validation tools, the following were used:
